


The Reporting Space will be visible from June 25 until August 14, 2025.

### Student's 'All Work Feed'

Your child's SpacesEDU account provides access to ALL of the student's work, posts, activities, and summative reports for all of their years using SpacesEDU via the 'All Work Feed'. Even after August 14, when classes are archived, your child's account will still maintain access to everything. To access any past posts, activities, or summative reports, have your child log into their SpacesEDU account and click on 'All Work Feed'. Your parent access for the 24/25 year will end on Aug. 14. 
