This year, we are hoping to reduce the number of field trip forms you have to sign. While this list of field trips may not include everything your child can experience at school, it will hopefully pull all known info into one place. Any additional trips will come home on separate forms.

Prior to a field trip day, your child's teacher will send you reminder info through your child's agenda and/or electronic communication so that you remember to send him/her with the right materials for the day. You keeping up to date with your child's school activities makes things easiest for everyone!

For all field trips that include a lunch break, please send a lunch that does not require heating up. Also, consider clothing for the weather for that day, including transportation time and having to be outside (i.e. waiting for a bus to arrive) and clothing for the activity, especially proper footwear.

Events marked with ** are whole school events and the others are unique to your child's class and/or grade. As much info as we have is included here for each event, and you need to **initial each box that you are signing** for as well as complete the information at the bottom of the page. Should your emergency contact information change at any time through the year, please let the office and your child's teacher know so that we can make changes to this form.

Please remember that due to both booking contracts and safety considerations, siblings are not permitted to join in on field trips. All family members, however, are invited to attend masses and our school Christmas Concert dress rehearsal.

Thank you for your support of this new venture for our school. If you would like to volunteer for any of your child's field trips, please reply to any class requests made by your child's teacher or the class parent rep. Information about volunteer/chaperone requirements are coming out soon in a separate note.

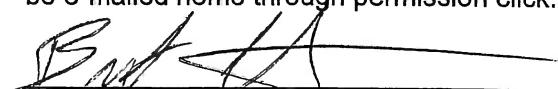
